State law prohibits members of the Board from commenting on any statement or engaging in dialogue without an appropriate agenda item being posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act. Comments should be directed to the entire Board, not individual members. Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign, or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of time privileges.)
2. Approve minutes.
3. Update from Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 412, including report from the Joint Facilities Committee.
4. Report from Communications Committee, including District website matters and tree planting event.
5. Report from Best Trash.
6. Security matters, including the Constable's report and report from the Security Committee.
7. Approve Annual Report and authorize filing of same in accordance with the District's Continuing Disclosure of Information Agreement and as required by SEC Rule 15c2-12.
8. Annual Review of Procedures for Continuing Disclosure Compliance.
9. Review and update Eminent Domain Report to the Texas Comptroller.
10. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors winter conference.
11. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
12. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.

Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 504 reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by Texas Government Code, Section 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), Section 551.072 (Deliberations Regarding Real Property), Section 551.073 (Deliberations Regarding Gifts and Donations), Section 551.074 (Personnel Matters), Section 551.076 (Deliberations Regarding Security Matters), and Section 551.087 (Economic Development).

 - d. lift station nos. 2 and 3 generator additions;
 - e. rehabilitation of ground storage tank no. 2 (interior and exterior) and ground storage tank no. 1 (exterior);
 - f. District Capital Improvement Plan and Joint Capital Improvement Plan with Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 412;
 - g. commercial development and District plan review;
 - h. utility commitment letters, including nontaxable user fee calculations; and
 - i. other engineering matters.
